Wraparound Care

We understand the importance of before and after school provision for busy and working parents, which is why we provide a 'Wraparound Care' facility for all our girls from 7:30am each morning (Breakfast Club) until 6:00pm Monday to Thursday (Twilight Club). Our Wraparound Care facility is operated by QCPS staff, which allows close liaison with Form Teachers and parents. A programme of varied activities ensures girls attending Wraparound Care can relax and enjoy some free time before and after school. Our breakfast menu reflects our healthy eating policy, and all dishes are freshly prepared daily onsite.

Breakfast Club or Twilight Club are available on a regular or ad-hoc basis. To book a Twilight Club, please contact Miss Dina (edina@qcps.org.uk) and please note that the Twilight Club dismissal door is 61 Portland Place.

Pre-Prep Cub clubs run from 3:20-3:55pm and Prep Cub clubs run from 3:30-4:00pm. Lioness Clubs are run by QCPS staff members and external providers from 4-5pm and are charged. Breakfast club and Twilight club are also charged. Please be advised that Twilight is now charged in increments of 30 minutes to enable us to make our prices fair for all.
