

Wraparound Care

We understand the importance of before and after school provision for busy and working parents, which is why we provide Wraparound Care for all our girls from 7:30am each morning (Breakfast Club) until 6:00pm Monday to Thursday (Twilight Club). Our Wraparound Care facility is operated by QCPS staff, which allows close liaison with Form Teachers and parents. A programme of varied activities ensures girls attending our Wraparound Care sessions can relax and enjoy some free time before and after school. Our breakfast menu reflects our healthy eating policy, and all dishes are freshly prepared daily onsite.
